

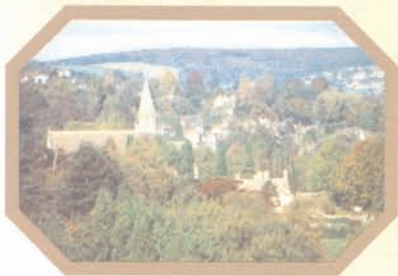
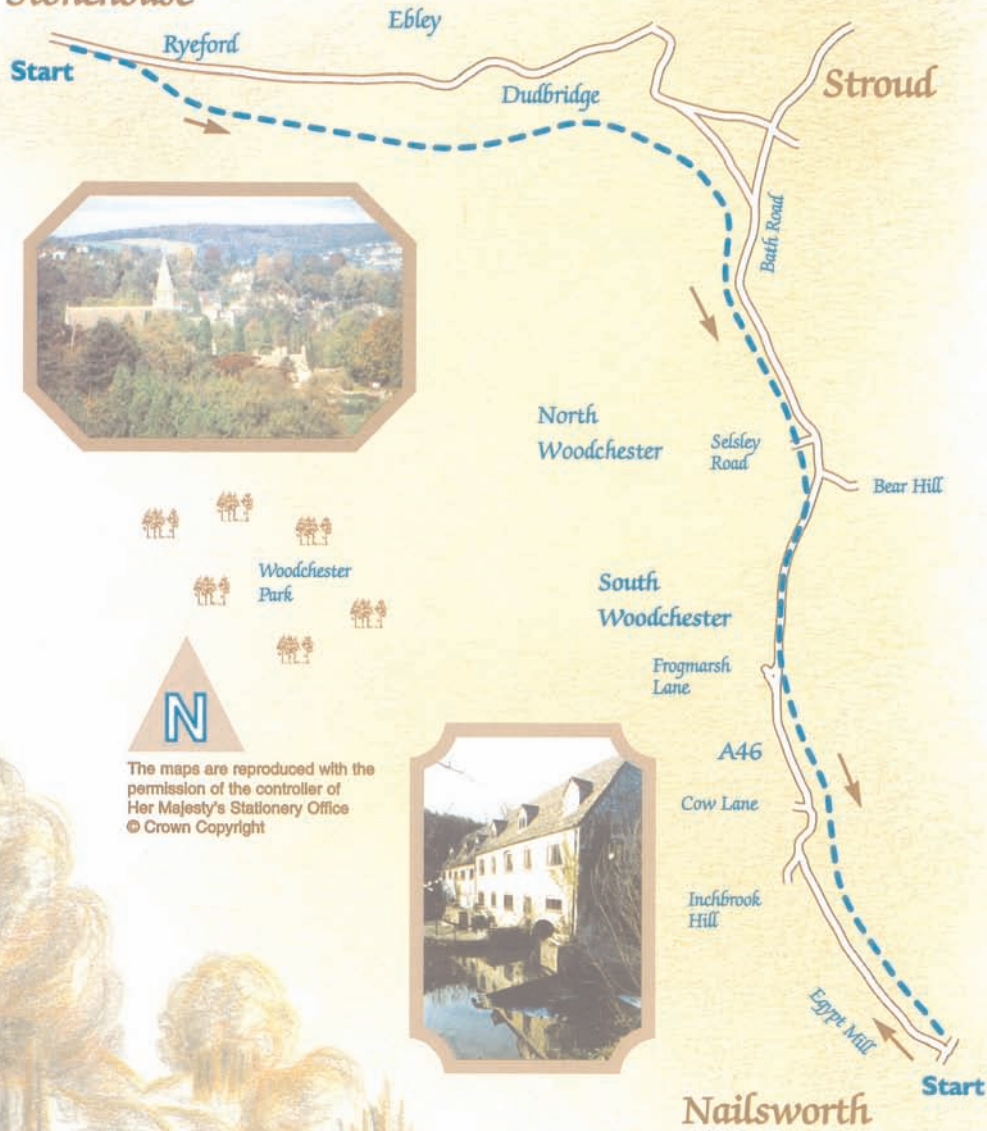

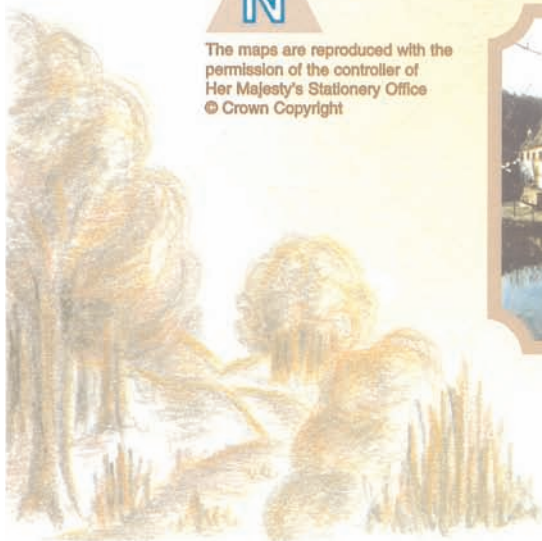

## Eastington - Nailsworth

### Start . . . Pike Lock, Eastington

***Please be aware that this is not a circular walk***

Starting at Pike Lock follow Canal tow path until you pass under a disused railway bridge and you are confronted by a new road bridge. **DO NOT PASS UNDER THIS BRIDGE** but climb steps on right hand side to main road, turn right and follow the cycle path signs to Nailsworth.

It provides a level and largely peaceful alternative to the main roads and is a haven for wildlife.

The route may be walked in either direction and can be accessed from various points along the way thus enabling you to make the walk as long or as short as you wish.

The Stroud Valleys Pedestrian Cycle Trail Leaflet (available from Tourist Information Centres and cycle shops) gives a guide to the natural and industrial history of this area. You may find it useful to take a copy along with you.

- Off Road Parking is not possible at Eastington but Off Street Parking is available in Stonehouse just off the High Street. Off Road Parking is possible at the Nailsworth start of this walk. Off Street Parking is also available in Old Market, Nailsworth.

The Stroudwater Canal  
The many old textile mills  
situated along the canal

The Ryeford (*between Stonehouse and Ebley*)  
The Old Fleece (*Rooksmoor*)  
Egypt Mill (*Nailsworth*)  
Tubby's Cafe (*Nailsworth*)
