

Frocester and Coaley

Start . . . Frocester crossroads

This is a very pleasant walk taking in pastureland, woods and hamlets.

From the public house in Frocester take the Coaley road. After approximately 100m, turn left to cross footbridge and cricket field to bridge at rear of garages in right hand corner. Turn right, and keeping to right hand boundary, pass farm buildings to gateway by old oak tree. Through gate, turn left and immediately through second gate and cross field diagonally to exit in far right hand corner next to electric pylon. Turn half right across field to stile, then diagonally over field to end of hedge and footbridge, cross and turn left. Cross two further fields passing cattle trough to stile on left, cross into small wood then immediately right over stile. Follow right hand hedge to double stile in hedge line, cross and turn left. Follow left hand boundary, then out across field to stile by wooden electric pole crossing further field. Exit in far left hand corner to road.

Cross road into field and diagonally cross field in direction of wooden electric poles to stile and stepping stones across ditch. Cross and follow right hand boundary over two stiles then diagonally cross field in direction of red bricked house. Cross stile and along small alley to road, turn left.

At road junction take the Uley road, passing Knapp Lane and "The White House" then take the first lane left. Follow lane up to drive gate and passing to the right climb between fence and hedgerow to stile in fence on right. Here turn left to follow woodland path along edge of wood for a good way. At branch turn right and then left down to lane, cross and re-

enter wood. Continue to where a number of tracks meet. Go straight ahead climbing, on through wood to exit into field over stile. Straight across field and rise to stile and lane.

Turn left down lane then right along bridle path past cottages. Over cattle grid through two metal gates into field. Turn left down valley to where a track intersects hedge line. Go through gate ahead and diagonally across field in direction of barn, cross fence through gate and over bridge, turn left. In front of barn turn right over stile and cross field diagonally half left to gate in far right hand corner into road. Turn left and following road return to Frocester.

• Points of interest -

1. Coaley Peak.
2. Frocester Court (largest used tythe barn in Gloucestershire.)
3. Site of Roman Villa.
4. Frocester Manor.

• Places to eat -

1. The George Inn, Frocester.
2. Fox & Hounds, Coaley.

- Parking may be possible at The George Inn, but please ask permission from the Landlord.
